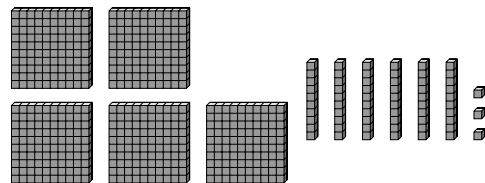

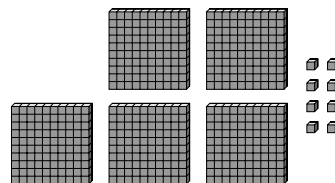
Problem Solving *Visual Thinking*
